

How to Assemble and Pack Away Your Airflow Adventure

Your Airflow Adventure system will come ready assembled and will simply require careful positioning, pegging down and attachment to the fan unit before use. Please read the instructions and safety notice below, before starting to position the item for play.

Before You Start

1. This leaflet gives instructions for assembling your Airflow Adventure. Please read them carefully.
2. We recommend that you check all parts against the Parts List before starting. Do this by laying out the parts on a flat surface.
3. Two adults should assemble the Airflow Adventure system.
4. Assembly should take approximately 15 minutes. Taking time over assembly helps to ensure safety.

Assembly

1. Once you have checked that all parts are present, position your Airflow Adventure on a level surface, ideally grass or sand – NEVER on a hard surface.
2. Please ensure that you have adequate space for assembly and allow at least 2 m (80") around each face of the system. For comfort and safety, you should clear away any stones etc. from the play zone.
3. Each pod includes openings as entry and/or exit points. You may use any of these openings as an entry or exit point depending upon the configuration decided for the assembly. Tunnels should be used as escape hatches only.

4. The assembly may be configured in a square, straight, 'L', 'Z' or 'T' shape (see overleaf).

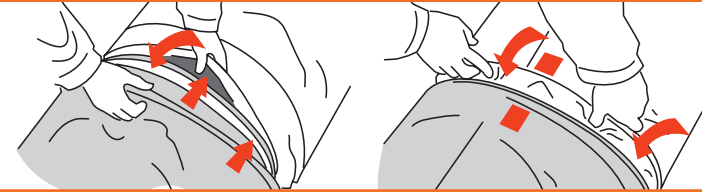
5. The connection of tunnels, doors and seals are detailed in the following diagrams. When connecting tunnels please ensure that the red markers on the tunnels and pods are aligned.

6. Connect to airflow fan.

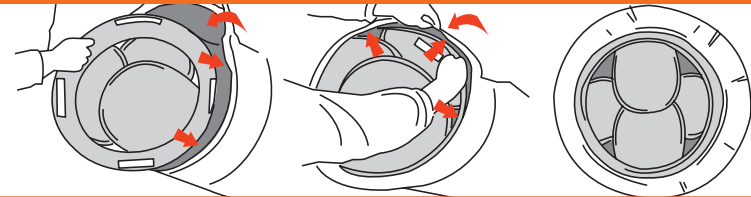
7. Once you have assembled your Airflow Adventure (ensure that the air intake tube remains firmly fixed to the fan at all times), switch on the fan and watch a different world appear in seconds!

8. Airflow Adventures have been fitted with 'magic' stay closed doors on all pods, and Velcro fitted doors on the tops of the tunnels. To ensure maximum enjoyment from Airflow Adventures, please ensure that during play all doors and seals remain closed to avoid unnecessary air-loss.

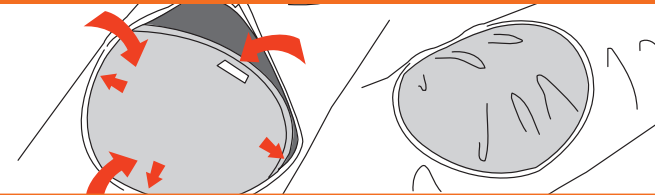
Connecting a Tunnel



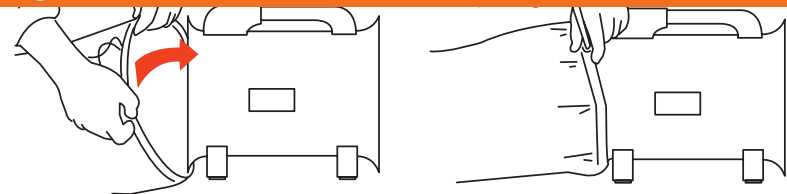
Connecting a Door

IMPORTANT: The assembly and packing away of your Airflow Adventure should always be carried out by two responsible adults. If you have any questions, please telephone our Customer Services Department on +44 151 495 1677 who will be delighted to help.

How to Assemble and Pack Away Your Airflow Adventure

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTES

1. Children should always be supervised by at least 1 adult at all times.
2. The Airflow Adventures system should not be used outdoors during inclement weather.
3. Do not wear shoes whilst playing with Airflow Adventures.
4. Do not allow children to climb onto the product.
5. The fan should only be connected to a mains supply fitted with an RCCB type circuit breaker.
6. This fan must not be sited near any item emitting fumes, e.g. BBQ's.
7. This fan must not be operated by children.
8. Inflation/Deflation should only be carried out by an adult. Ensure that all children have exited the structure before deflation.
9. Keep children away from the fan whilst in use.
10. Store indoors.

12. When packing away your Airflow Adventures, take care to remove all toys and other objects from within the product, and place the product back into its packaging.
13. Please check that the electrical cable has not been damaged each time before use. If it is damaged, switch off, disconnect the fan immediately and consult a qualified electrician.

14. When used outdoors, Airflow Adventures must be pegged down using the pegs supplied. Position pegs so that they lie within the boundaries of the product (to avoid trip hazards), and away from the floor of the product where children may crawl.

Care of Your Airflow Adventure System

The Pods and accessories may be wipe cleaned only using a soft sponge and detergent for best effect.

Your Airflow Adventures has been manufactured from tough Nylon and Polyester and should remain free of defects for many years. If, however, you accidentally tear the fabric, it may be sewn together again using standard needle and thread.

Do not allow the fan unit to become wet. If it does become wet, wipe it dry immediately using a clean dry cloth.
